



Hotel Daniel

With its monolithic glass exterior, Hotel Daniel looks as if it could be the HQ of a pharmaceutical concern, which in fact the building once was. Completed in 1962 by Georg Lippert and Roland Rohn, the structure was renovated in 2011 by local architects Atelier Heiss, who fashioned 115 rooms out of the former offices. The facade is now under historic preservation, thanks to which each accommodation

has views for miles down Vienna's outer ring road. Inside, hotelier Florian Weitzer has combined vintage with heirloom and design pieces. Rooms are minimally furnished, and feature walnut headboards, unfinished ceilings and hammocks; book the Panorama Room 605 (above), which offers a full overview of the city.
